APPLICATION	Cleaning solvents are used in construction work to clean tools, equipment and within shop, for general cleaning.
PROTECTIVE MECHANISMS	WHMIS MSDS in place & current PPE Respiratory protection {if required} ERP (Emergency Response Plan)
SELECTION AND USE	As per job requirement
SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY	To facilitate and/or provide proper instruction to their workers on protection requirements
WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure all WHMIS requirements are met. 2. Check toxic hazards of all solvents before use. (M.S.D.S.) 3. When breathing hazards exists, use the appropriate respiratory protection. 4. Use non-flammable solvents for general cleaning. 5. Store flammables and solvents in special storage containers/areas. 6. Ensure that proper containers are used for transportation, storage and field use of solvents/flammables. 7. Do not use solvents in areas where food may be contaminated.
