

Occupational Health and Safety for the Asbestos Worker Training Course

This two-day course is designed for supervisors and workers who are involved with asbestos abatement projects.

Course Objectives:

This course is developed for the purpose of training employees on asbestos abatement procedures.

Course Content:

- Introduce asbestos
- Explain the health effects of asbestos
- Review applicable legislation
- Explain the different abatement methods
- Provide information on asbestos abatement site conditions
- Explain abatement procedures
- Identify the proper respiratory protection
- Explain air monitoring
- Identify other hazards

Summary

Participants who successfully meet the course requirements (successfully completing the Asbestos Worker Course Exam attaining 80% or better) will be issued an Occupational Health and Safety for the Asbestos Worker certificate. This certificate is valid for three years and is required for all high risk abatement jobs within the Northwest Territories and Nunavut.
