

## **Temporary Traffic Control Course (ATTC)**

Traffic control technicians, in partnership with the American Traffic Safety Services Association (ATSSA), designed this two-day course. The course is delivered by traffic control experts selected by industry representatives in conjunction with the NSA. The target audience for this course are those involved in developing, assisting in set up and/or in monitoring the implementation of temporary traffic control plans.

### **Course Objectives:**

- To provide information to participants regarding temporary traffic control practices
- To assist in skill development for those who are responsible for developing and maintaining temporary traffic control strategies for road construction
- To assist in understanding the theoretical portion of worker competency in implementing a temporary traffic control plan
- To create a safer work zone
- To establish consistent temporary traffic control standards throughout Alberta

### **Pre-requisites:**

- Recommended - Completion of the Temporary Traffic Control – Field Application course, or
- Recommended - Completion of an equivalent program such as the ATSSA Work Site Traffic Technician Course or the On-Site Construction Maintenance Course

### **Certification:**

This course has a written exam component for which participants must achieve a minimum score of 80% for course certification. Certification is valid for a period of four (4) years. Participants will be required to pass a quiz (80% or better) upon completion of the course.

### **Re-certification:**

To re-certify, the individual is required to complete either of the following prior to the expiration of their certificate:

- Re-take the course
- Successfully challenge the exam
