

Transportation of Dangerous Goods Train-The-Trainer

This one-day course is for those individuals involved in, or responsible for handling, shipping, receiving, offering for transport and transporting dangerous goods.

Course Objectives:

- **To provide participants:**
- Certification to conduct training
- Information relating to developing and/or maintaining a site-specific TDG Program

Course Content:

- Classifications of dangerous goods
- Applicable safety markings and means of containment
- Required shipping documentation
- Dangerous Occurrence reporting and accidental releases
- Applicable legislation elements and requirements
- Exemptions
- Training
- Enforcement process and fines

Participants who successfully meet the course requirements (successfully completing an “unassisted” exam attaining 80% or better result) will be issued a TDG Train-the-Trainer certificate. Certification allows the trainer to conduct in-house training, using NSA materials.

Re-certification is required every three years and can be achieved by taking the one-day course again, or by successfully challenging the online exam.

This course qualifies for 0.5 BCRSP Certificate maintenance points. (CPM 10212)
